April 2010 Block of the Month

The block at we will be making this month is a split 9 patch. It is a nine patch block that is half dark and half light. It is very scrappy please use lots of fabrics and make it definitely dark and light. This block is very versatile and can be used to make lots and lots of patterns for quilts. Please use black Moda cotton for the center square.

Dark Fabric—cut 3 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 1 square $3\frac{7}{8}$ " (cut diagonally once)

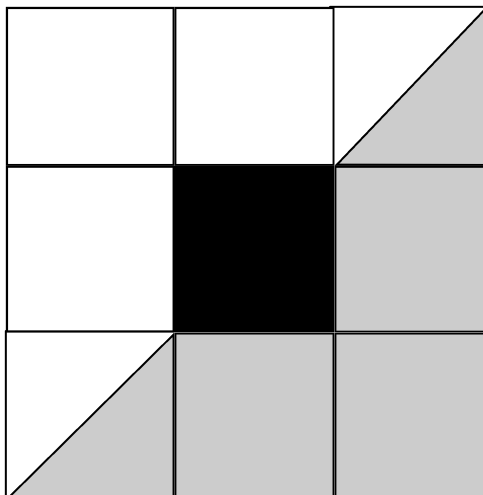
Middle Black Moda Cotton fabric cut one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Light Fabric—cut 3 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 1 square $3\frac{7}{8}$ " (cut diagonally once)

Make 2 half square triangles with the light/dark triangles. These should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make them scrappy using 9 to 11 different fabrics.



These split 9 patch blocks should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " when turned in.
