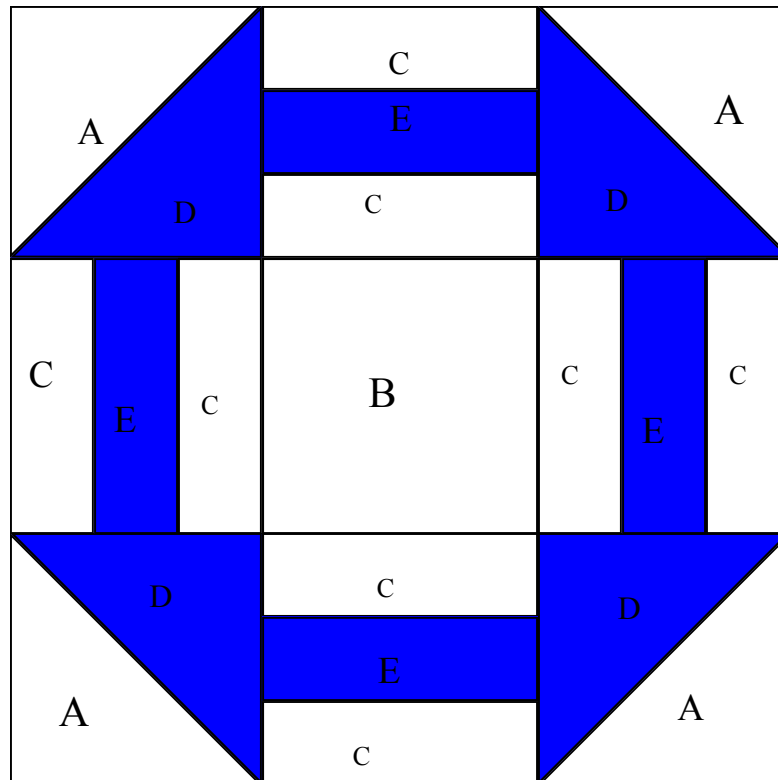

Block of the Month

Crow's Nest 9" finished



Colors—Medium Blue and white on white for the background

Cutting—White (background)

A- Cut two $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares

B- Cut one $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square

C- Cut eight $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cutting—Blue

D- cut two $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares

E- cut eight $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Use the $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares to make the half square triangles. Mark a diagonal line on the white square. Layer the blue with the marked square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the marked line. Cut the units apart between the lines.

Use the rectangles to make the side units. Assemble 4 units with the blue rectangle between the white rectangles.

Assemble the block as shown. When turned in the block will measure $9 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
