2010 QUILT SHOW RULES

1. All entries must be completely finished, clean and in good condition.
2. All entries must have a fabric ID or label attached to the lower right hand corner of the back and must have owner's name and address and telephone number. Quilt must be enclosed in a fabric bag that is also labeled. Each entrant will receive a receipt for each quilt entered.
This receipt **MUST** be presented to reclaim the entry. Any agent for you who is picking up your entry **MUST** have the receipt with them.
3. Entries previously exhibited at the Senior Center Quilt Show or QGPC show will not be accepted.
4. Entry pre-registration is required. Forms are available upon request at:
www.quiltersguildofparkercounty.org or Call 817 599-9934
5. All entries must be displayed for the entire show. NO quilts will be removed prior to 4PM
September 25, 2010.
6. All quilt entries are required to have a 4" sleeve. Quilts with extra length should have the sleeve at no more than 90" from the bottom of the quilt. Antique quilts do not need a sleeve.
7. A 2" sleeve is advised on any miniature quilts.
8. Entry Fee is \$6.00 per quilt for members, \$11.00 per quilt for non-members. Make checks payable to: Quilter's Guild Of Parker County or QGPC.
9. Deadline for quilt entries is: August 19, 2010. This allows time to prepare information sheets for the quilts and the show book. Bring your quilts to the Sheriff's Posse building between 10:00 AM & 12:00 PM on Thursday, September 23rd.
10. Mail entry forms to: Phyllis Thornton, 205 Saddle Club Rd., Weatherford, TX. 76088 **by Aug. 19, 2010** or turn them in at any guild meeting (to Phyllis Thornton or Judy Fitzgerald) no later than the August 19th Guild Meeting .
11. The guild does not have insurance. Reasonable care will be taken to protect your entry. Please be aware that the Quilter's Guild Of Parker County or any member cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to your entries
12. Quilts need to be picked up at the Sheriff's Posse on Saturday, September 25th Between 4PM and 5PM.

Definitions: We reserve the right to re-categorize quilts.

Size determination is based on the measurement of the longest edge of the quilt.

Mixed Technique:

- ♥ Any size is acceptable
- ♥ Any quilt that does not fit other category requirements, such as yo-yo quilts, cathedral window quilts, stenciled quilts, crayon work, embroidered quilts, crazy quilts, whole cloth, tied quilts.

Wearable Art:

- ♥ The piece must be intended to be worn as a garment.
- ♥ The piece must be constructed with piecing or applique and contain three layers.
- ♥ The garment must contain some recognizable quilting.
- ♥ Novelty techniques are accepted and include crazy quilting and yo-yo's etc.

Challenge Quilts:

- ♥ The quilt must be under 40" in any one direction. The theme this year is: **Stitches From The Heart**

By my signature below, I agree to abide by all conditions stated on this entry form and accompanying instructions. Permission to photograph this entry for the QGPC files, publicity or promotion either in print or electronic media remains in effect unless revoked IN WRITING by me.
