

Cookie Cutter Applique Class Supply List by Linda Neal

Cookie Cutters--any size/type (Linda will bring some to use if you don't have any)

Small Craft Iron--The Clover Wedge iron is perfect. If you have another small iron that's fine (such as, the travel irons we take to retreats) just make sure it gets HOT. This iron could be shared.

Mini Iron--Cheri's Cool Tool (Available at Cheriscrystals.com for \$21.95) or the Clover mini-iron is OK. You MUST have one for class. These cannot be shared.

Extension Cord(s)--You need these to give you flexible movement with your mini-iron.

Silicone Hot Pad (from Bed Bath and Beyond or Walmart) keeps your irons from burning tables or falling onto floor during class.

Scissors--Linda's preferences are listed in the box below, but do not buy scissors specifically for this class as they are expensive. Bring scissors you have that will work for these purposes.

Scissors For Fabric: Linda prefers serrated – Kai purple handle or Karen Kay Buckley middle size - light blue handle

Scissors For Paper: curved and straight scissors in a variety of sizes. (Linda uses Kai 4 inch straight and curved, and Kai 5 1/2 curved)

Applique Scissors- straight, sharp tip

Pins--Flower head pins or a similar large pin, just a few are needed.

Stiletto--one with a good sharp metal point that feels comfortable to you

Clover 1/4 Bias Maker (it MUST be the green one-NOT the purple one). You could share this.

Clover Wonder Clips--helpful, but not required

Pressing Board—Like June Taylor Quilter's Cut 'n Press board, OR a wool mat with a piece of cotton fabric on it. The cotton fabric protects the mat from glue and starch.

1/4 White Foam Core Board--available from Walmart or office supply, cut to 12X12

Ultra-Fine Sharpie or Micron Pen--any color

Pencil

Paint Brush--1/4 inch angled brush (available from Hobby Lobby, Michaels, etc.)

Parchment Paper--roll or pre-cut sheets, you need 1 piece (**Will be provided by the Guild**)

Freezer Paper--one 8 1/2 x 11 sheet is all you need. Cut-Rite is Linda's favorite. Jenkins is Ok too. (**Will be provided by the Guild**)

Regular Starch (NOT heavy duty)--a small container (aerosol or non-aerosol)

Glue--Roxanne's Glue Baste It or Elmer's Washable Glue (it must dispense from a small tip)

Aleene's OK to Wash It--This is a permanent glue used to hold fraying threads in place. Could be shared.

Thread to match project and desired **applique needle, needle threader** if needed.

Fabric--Background fabric- 1 FQ. Scraps or FQ of creams, light browns for cookies and pastel colors for frosting. Brown for sticks. **Please pre-wash or rinse fabrics prior to class.**
