**Mini Option Overview of the Square in a Square technique system
(concentrating on the SQUARE plus highlighting the main DIAMOND Options)**

Workshop - All skill levels

During this workshop, you will learn how the Square in a Square system works, from sewing the basic squares to learning the trimming of the Options to understanding the conversion charts.

- We will concentrate on the “square options” (those made by starting with a square). We will learn the beginning Options 1, 3, 4, and 8 as well as learning the charts for each.
- Additionally, we will highlight the main “diamond options” (those starting with a diamond). We will look at Options 7, 18, 19, 20 and their corresponding charts
- Cutting, sewing and pressing of the shapes as well as understanding the conversion charts will allow the student to create and adapt other patterns to the system. This is a mini version of what would be taught during our Certified Teacher training session.

Basic Supply List: sewing machine, thread, rotary cutter & mat, basic sewing supplies, stiletto, Square in a Square Original R-8 ruler OR the smaller R-5 ruler plus Square in a Square Reference Book, Vol. 1, Diamonds by the Square Reference Book, Vol. 2, Omni-grid 6”x12” or 6”x18” ruler. Optional: Bring a pattern or two that you would like to learn how to pattern adapt.
The rulers and books will be available at the workshop.

Fabric and Cutting Supply List

Pre-cut the following: 10 – 3” light color squares 1 – 3” light color strip (selvedge to selvedge)
10 – 1 ¾” dark strips (selvedge to selvedge) 4 – 2” dark strips (selvedge to selvedge)

Additional: (10) – 8.5 in. x 11 in. card stock paper sheets (1) – glue stick
