Recipe Corner

Cauliflower Popcorn

1 Lg. head cauliflower

1/2 tsp. garlic salt

1 T. olive oil

1 T. Parmesan cheese

Break cauliflower into small florets. Toss with 1 T. olive oil and 1/2 tsp. garlic salt. Transfer to a greased baking sheet. Bake at 400 degrees for 15 to 18 minutes or until tender, stirring once. Sprinkle with 1 T. grated Parmesan cheese.

Spiced Nuts

1 egg white

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. water

1/2 tsp. ground cloves

3/4 c sugar

2 c. walnuts or pecans

1 1/2 tsp. cinnamon

Beat egg white with water until stiff. Combine sugar, cinnamon, salt and ground cloves in a separate bowl. Pour nuts into stiff egg whites and toss to coat. Pour nuts into sugar and spice mixture. Spread onto greased cookie sheet, separating nuts as much as possible. Bake at 275 degrees for 30 minutes.


