QGPC Quilt Show Rules 2018

Entry preregistration is required and entry forms must be received by August 16, 2018. Forms are available at www.quiltersguildofparkercounty.org, at guild meetings or call 918-332-6430. Entry fee is \$6.00 per quilt for members and \$15.00 per quilt for non-members. Make checks payable to "Quilter's Guild of Parker County" or "QGPC". Quilts must be entered by their owner. Please submit a photo of the quilt with the application for identification purposes.

1. All entries must be finished, clean, free of lint and pet hair, and in good condition. The acceptable condition of antique quilts for the bed turning is up to the historian conducting the bed turning.
2. All entries must have a fabric ID or label attached to the lower right corner of the back and must have the name of the quilt and the owner's name on it. **Please cover the label on all quilts which will be judged with a piece of fabric (muslin is fine) attached with safety pins.**
3. All quilts except miniatures and antiques, must have a 4" sleeve: (HOW TO MAKE A SLEEVE: Cut fabric 9"wide by the width of the quilt. Hem each end ½ ". Fold the piece lengthwise wrong side out and stitch the long side raw edges together with 1/4" seam. Turn right side out and press with the seam near the bottom. Stitch the sleeve on the back of the quilt. Make sure to stitch the seamed ends of your quilt down also). Extra-long quilts should have the sleeve at no more than 90" from the bottom of the quilt – extra-long quilts which do not comply will not be exhibited – there will be no quilts "spilling" onto the floor.
4. Entries must be taken to Northside Baptist Church between 7:30am and 9am on Thursday, September 20, 2018. Each entrant will receive a receipt for each quilt entered. This receipt **MUST** be presented to reclaim the entry. If an agent for you is picking up your entry, the agent **MUST** have the receipt.
5. Entries previously exhibited at any QGPC show at any location will not be accepted.
6. All entries must be displayed for the entire show. No entry will be released prior to pick up time – 4:45 to 5:30 on Saturday, September 22, 2018

8. We reserve the right to re-categorize quilts. Should a quilt have more than one form of quilting present it will be categorized according to the predominate quilting technique used. Size determination is based on the measurement of the longest side of the quilt.

Definitions:

Modern:

Any quilt that is not traditional in design, with focus on geometrical or abstract shapes and use of negative space.

Mixed Technique:

Any quilt that does not fit other category requirements, such as cathedral window, stenciled, crayon work, embroidered, tied, whole cloth or yo-yo quilts.

Junior Quilter:

The maximum age to be considered a Junior Quilter is 16.

Challenge Quilts:

Any size quilt. The theme this year is "Quilts in Bloom". Please write an explanation of your quilt (interpretation of the theme) on your entry form.

These quilts are individual interpretation - only 1 entry per person.
