



## WHEEL OF SCRAPS Divide & Conquer Circles 9° at a Time

Come let me take the mystery out of piecing beautiful circles with the 9° Circle Wedge Ruler. Use all the left over strips sitting on your shelves to make these wonderful pieced circles. You can use strips in all lengths and widths for this easy to piece quilt. These are BIG blocks. Make 1 block for a wall hanging or 3 blocks for a larger quilt. Scrap borders can also be added. We will discuss different layouts, piecing and quilting. This quilt is even jelly roll friendly!

I have listed the yardage requirements and supply list for a single circle wall hanging and a three circle quilt as shown above.

**During class students will work on the pieced circle for the center block.**

### SINGLE BLOCK 27" x 27"

1 1/2 yards background  
Lots of Scraps  
(approximately 1 yard of scraps or a jelly roll)  
\*2/3 yard for bias (optional)  
\*1 yard backing  
\*1/4 yard for binding  
or use leftover strips for binding

### THREE BLOCK 55" x 55"

4 1/2 yards background  
Lots of Scraps  
(approximately 2 yards of scraps or a jelly roll)  
\*1 yard for bias (optional)  
\*3 1/2 yards backing  
\*1/2 yard for binding  
or use leftover strips for binding

### OTHER SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Sewing machine in good working order  
Neutral thread for sewing  
Thread to match background fabric selection  
9° Wedge Ruler (I will have ruler available for \$28.00 to students.)  
Rotary cutter, mat (18" x 24" ) and 6" x 24" ruler

### BEFORE CLASS:

**If you are using scraps** from your stash, please cut your scraps into a variety of different widths ( 1 1/2" to 3") Your strips do not have to be 42" long, but they do need to be at least 4" long. They can be a variety of different lengths and widths.

**If you are using a jelly roll**, please follow these pre class cutting instructions: Select 20 strips from your jelly roll. Cut 2 pieces, each 2 1/2" x 11" long from each of the 20 strips. Cut 1 of the 2 1/2" x 11" strips in half to form 2—1 1/4" x 11" strips. Repeat for each of the 20 different selected strips.

Your scraps can be a single color family or multi colors.
