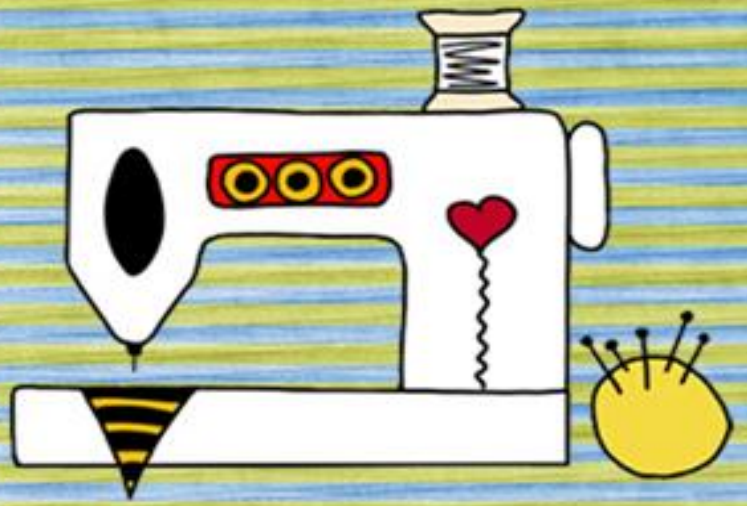


Ready Set Sew!

We are pleased to announce that the October meeting of the Quilter's Guild of Parker County will be a Sew-In to benefit our Comfort Quilts program.

As you can imagine, things will be a little different from our normal gatherings. We are limiting the size of the sew-in to 30 people. This ensures that we are well within the social distancing guidelines. A complete list of the guidelines is in this email. Please review them and be prepared to honor them if you decide to attend. Registration is open to all Guild members, first come, first in. Just email Rex Shrauner (wreckser@hotmail.com) to reserve your spot. We will plan Zoom meetings throughout the day so that those not comfortable attending can still participate from home.

Unlike our traditional sew-ins, we will all work on the same block pattern. The block is "Colorful Diamonds" and is from the video we watched during the September Zoom meeting. It is a very simple block to make with only straight seams to sew. The pattern and supply list are on the Guild website, quiltersguildofparkercounty.org.

Plan to practice using the color wheel! Bring large scraps (min 6" squares) of whatever colors you like. Bring as many scraps of as many colors as you can. Also, bring cream/cream print scraps (min. 2.5" x 5"). We will use the color wheel to sort them, and use six to twelve fabrics of a single color to make our block. Be sure to bring some "hard-to-match" fabrics; we can help each other figure out how to use them!

This small meeting is a low-risk way to test our readiness to reopen and will allow us to test our online capabilities. With patience, creativity and smiles, the Guild can be stronger and reach more people than ever before.
