~Label things that might get mixed up with your name, like rotary cutters, rulers, extension cords, etc.

Sewing machine stuff

- Sewing machine, recently cleaned & oiled + manual if necessary
- Foot pedal and power cord**
- Extension cord and power bar
- Extra needles
- Lots of bobbins, pre-wound at home if possible
- Screwdriver
- Lint brush
- Machine oil
- All the machine feet you might need – ¼' foot, walking foot, topstitch foot, applique foot, free motion foot
- Fabric scraps for testing tensions or other issues
- (Optional) Machine extension table
- (Optional) Portable machine table
- (Optional) Chair or chair cushion

- Paper, sketchbook, notebook, pens, pencils, sharpie
- Post-it notes or notepad
- Glasses
- Prescriptions
- Refillable water bottle
- Painkillers

- Small (12"X18") or medium (18" X 24") cutting mat
- Rotary cutter + extra blades
- Empty rotary blade box for used blades & used/broken pins/needles
- Several rulers, plus any specialty rulers needed
- Seam ripper

- Pincushion & pins
- Needles and thimble


