Perfect Piecing Workshop - Supply List

Pattern and Fabric:

- The Perfect Piecing Workshop Sampler Pattern is an exclusive pattern for workshop use and will not be available for individual purchase. **You will receive the pattern after you have registered and paid for the workshop.**
- The pattern consists of traditional patchwork, flying geese, quarter square triangles and half square triangles.
- The pattern makes a 48” by 48” throw using approximately 2 ½ yards of fabric.
- The pattern is written for a modern 2-tone yardage version or a scrappy fat quarter version. You can also use a 10“ precut (layer cake) as well!
- **Fabrics should be cut before class to maximize learning time during class.**

Notions:

- Sewing machine with ¼" presser foot
- Rotary cutting mat and rotary cutter (a rotating cutting mat is helpful but not required)
- Basic sewing supplies (thread for piecing, pins and/or wonder clips, seam ripper, fabric marking pens, extra needles, and extra bobbins)
- Square quilting ruler with ¼” marks-16“ is the best size for squaring up blocks and 10“and 5“ are best for trimming individual blocks. If you do not have these sizes, bring the closest size!
- Flying geese specialty rulers–these are not mandatory but if you have them, bring to trim your flying geese to 4 ½” x 8 ½”
- Half square triangle specialty rulers–these are not mandatory but if you have them, bring them to trim your half square triangles to 4 ½”

*Skill Level: Confident Beginner

*Must have working knowledge of operating a sewing machine and basic piecing skills.

*Come to class with your machine cleaned and ready to use. Fill bobbins in your choice of thread for piecing.
