Read the back of your pattern for fabric suggestions and yardage that you will need. I have found that fat quarters of busy florals works well. You will need a calm fabric for some underlays. You may be able to do some trading in class with the other students.

6 yards of Steam a Seam 2 fusible

Applique Pressing Sheet

Black Sharpie pen

Pattern Ease (check your pattern for amount)

Sharp fabric scissors—I love Karen Kay Buckley's perfect scissors, the 4" (blue handle) works especially well for this

Pins

Background fabric-again check your pattern. I used one piece of fabric for background but a lot of these have pieced backgrounds. It is your choice. If you want to audition some and get help deciding please bring this with you. Also, it is really fun to collage the background, so you would need several smaller pieces of fabric.

Piece of pink foam core board to use for attaching your project. You will work really hard on getting your fabric pieces in the perfect place and don't want to have to take it all apart to get home.

You will not need a sewing machine for class. I will talk to you about options for appliquéing and quilting.
